### Purposes

The major purpose of the College of Education (COE) Faculty Council is to represent the COE Faculty in advising the Dean on matters directly related to the College in fulfillment of its mission.

Specifically, the Council shall:

1. Serve as a forum on matters pertaining to the role and mission of the College.
2. Seek to be representative of the interests, needs, and views of the COE faculty in general.
3. Consider all matters brought before it and make recommendations to the Dean concerning them.

### Membership

The maximum membership of the COE Faculty council shall be 14. Members shall be elected as follows:

1. Department of Curriculum, Instruction and Special Educational --two representatives
2. Department of Counseling and Educational Psychology -- two representatives
3. Department of Music Education--two representatives
4. Department of Kinesiology--two representatives
5. Department of Instructional Systems and Workforce Development--two representatives
6. Department of Leadership and Foundations – two representatives
7. Meridian Campus--one representative
8. All units other than academic departments (e.g., Rehabilitation Research and Training Center on Blindness and Low Vision, The Learning Center, Center for Educational Partnership and Early Childhood Institute) shall come together to select one representative.

Each member of the Council shall serve a period of two years. Election of members shall be held during the spring semester with membership to become official in August of the forthcoming academic year. To serve one must at least have the rank of the tenure assistant professor (elected

by all faculty members, instructor or above). A member may serve two consecutive terms, after which s/he is ineligible for membership on the Council for a year.

Officers of the COE Faculty Council shall consist of a Chair, Vice Chair, and Secretary. These officers shall be elected at the last Council meeting of the present academic year by a majority vote of the council or those members present at the meeting. Officers shall serve for a period of one year and may not serve more than two consecutive terms in one office.

The COE Faculty Council shall meet regularly during the academic year, August-May, and upon call of the Chair or petition of eight members. Meetings shall be conducted in accordance with specific guidelines developed by council members and/or Robert's Rule of Order. For conducting business, a quorum shall consist of eight members present and eligible to vote.

The Dean shall provide in the COE's budget and appropriation of funds and resources sufficient to allow the Faculty Council to perform its functions.
