Refine/enhance the skills of reflective practice for continuous improvement as a professional.</li> </ol>	<p>The graduate of the advanced program will demonstrate continuous improvement in the ability to deliver the educational services through the enhancement and refinement of the following:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. <b>Professionalism:</b> The knowledge, skills, and dispositions needed to become a professional and help all students learn; demonstration of responsible, ethical behavior, and good judgment.</li> <li>2. <b>Diversity:</b> Commitment to diversity and the ability to work with diverse groups.</li> <li>3. <b>Knowledge:</b> Pursuit and demonstration of in-depth knowledge in the discipline.</li> <li>4. <b>Assessment:</b> Competency in curriculum/training evaluation and assessment in the discipline.</li> <li>5. <b>Communication Skills:</b> Ability to use appropriate language, speak and write with clarity, and use standard English in writing and speaking; demonstration of good listening and interpersonal skills.</li> <li>6. <b>Social/Cultural Skills:</b> Belief that all students can learn and the relevant social and cultural skills for a diverse educational environment; tolerant, fair, and culturally appropriate behavior.</li> <li>7. <b>Technology:</b> The ability to infuse appropriate technology into professional practice.</li> <li>8. <b>Reflection:</b> Use of self-reflection for improvement of student learning and personal and professional growth.</li> <li>9. <b>Collaboration:</b> Genuine collaboration with <i>all</i> stakeholders (recipients) in the world of practice.</li> <li>10. <b>Inquiry and Problem-solving:</b> Ability to demonstrate problem-solving skills in professional practice.</li> <li>11. <b>Pedagogy:</b> Demonstration of competency in instruction/training in the discipline.</li> <li>12. <b>Curriculum Development:</b> Demonstration of competency in curriculum/training development in the discipline.</li> <li>13. <b>Research:</b> Ability to use research findings to enhance instruction/training and advance knowledge in the discipline.</li> <li>14. <b>Issues/Trends:</b> Awareness of issues, problems, and trends in the area of professional practice.</li> </ol>
