Purposes and Procedures

“Changing Tomorrow Through Education Today”

The purpose of the Assessment Committee is to regularly engage in self-evaluation and assessment to improve operations and programs of the COE and coordinate the efforts of the COE in attending to the continuing accreditation expectations of the CAEP. This will involve regularly reviewing CAEP standards, developing and maintaining an integrated professional education core curriculum, developing a comprehensive program evaluation system, and regularly reviewing programs based on results of program reviews. This committee will be guided by the policies and procedures of the State Board of Education, the Institutions of Higher Learning Board, current CAEP standards, and current research on effective teaching. This committee will report to the Box Council through the chair.

Membership

The membership of this committee is comprised of representatives from each department and the Meridian Branch, the Associate Dean, and the Assistant Dean. Members will be appointed by department head with concurrence of the CAEP committee chair. Members must hold the rank of tenure track assistant professor or above with the exceptions of the OCFBI Director and the Assistant Dean who are appointed by the CAEP Coordinator. Each program area should be represented. The chair of this committee will be the individual designated as the CAEP Coordinator for the College.
