## Purpose

The College of Education Research Committee will provide guidance to the Dean and to the Associate Dean on promoting short-range and long-range goals related to increasing research collaboration with other colleges and increasing sponsored and non-sponsored research. The Committee will also be asked to help plan and organize an annual research forum and help increase professional development activities in the area of research, develop collaborative research teams centered around established "niche" areas, promote individual faculty research and collaborative research projects within the College, and otherwise foster or promote COE research activities, including the development and upkeep of a research web-page. The Committee shall be comprised of two appointed representatives from each Academic Department.

## Membership

The membership of this committee is comprised of two appointed representatives from each academic department, including the Division of Education (Meridian), and the Associate Dean. Members from the academic departments must hold the rank of assistant professor/assistant clinical professor or above.

Each member of the Research Committee shall serve a period of two years. A member may be appointed for no more than two consecutive terms. Members shall be appointed by the Dean and Associate Dean in consultation with each respective Department Head as appropriate. The appointments shall be made during the spring semester with membership to become official in August of the forthcoming academic year.
