## If you cannot answer YES to each item below, then do not submit your application.

- I have read, completed, and signed the Phase I form (typically completed at orientation).
- I have an overall GPA of 2.5 or higher.
- I have a grade of "C" or higher in English Comp I, English Comp II, and Mathematics (College Algebra, Quantitative Reasoning, or higher math).
- I have a composite ACT score of 21, OR an equivalent SAT score, OR I have passed the Praxis CORE exam. A copy of my scores has been sent to MSU (Code 1480).
- I have submitted and passed the Certified Background Check (CBC) from Castle Branch. <u>https://mycb.castlebranch.com/</u> Code MI43
- I have submitted two (2) recommendation forms from educators to the College of Education Dean's office.
- I have submitted the verification of 40 hours of work experience with youth/children.
- I have proof of professional liability insurance. (confirmation email)
- I have submitted the Pre-Service Licensure Information Form.
- I have purchased a 4 year subscription to Taskstream by Watermark.

When the above are completed, I will schedule a meeting with my academic advisor to:

- Review my CAPP for the required GPA on 44 hours coursework, including the 36 hour general education requirement (2.75 GPA required).
- Read and sign the Candidate Professional Disposition Form.
