Purposes and Procedures

Membership on the College of Education Data Science Committee will be comprised of one nominated faculty member from each academic department in Starkville. If the Data Science degree program is later added to the Meridian Campus, then a faculty member from MSU-M Division of Education will be added to the committee. For the first year of implementation (2022-2023), half of the committee will serve a 2-year term, while the other half will serve a 3-year term. After this, members will serve 2-year terms.

The purpose of the Data Science Committee will be to assist with developing concentrations for the BS degree in Data Science, as well as promoting and overseeing these concentration areas. The goals of the committee will be to

1. Develop 30 hour concentration areas in the College of Education

3. Promote the concentration areas for the College of Education
4. Oversee the concentration areas in the College of Education

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
