This table presents the institutional Title II summary licensure assessment results for Mississippi State University alternate route program completers during the 2024–2025 academic year.

Analysis of Results

During the 2024–2025 academic year, Mississippi State University alternate route program completers achieved an institutional licensure assessment pass rate of 92%. A total of 51 completers attempted one or more required licensure assessments, and 47 successfully met state-established performance requirements. These results indicate a high level of competency among alternate route completers.

The summary pass rate reflects each candidate being counted once regardless of the number of assessments attempted. This institution-level measure provides transparent evidence that Mississippi State University alternate route completers are meeting licensure expectations as they enter the education workforce.
